Introduced in 1979, prior to Pope John Paul II's historic visit to Philadelphia, the lighting along Boathouse Row has become an iconic feature along the Schuylkill River, where the site was listed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1987. The system transitioned to LED lighting in 2005 and was last refurbished in 2016. The current effort, worth \$2.1 million, will completely replace the failing system, which has struggled with connectivity challenges, regular power outages, and mounting issues. The system will mount the Row's iconic lights to 12 historic buildings and includes upgraded technology and durable housing boxes to protect the system from weather and wildlife damages. The presentation will review the history, concept development, and design of the relighting effort. The new system is scheduled to "go live" in early March, lighting up the houses for the first time since late 2022.
